Benefit Schedule

Plan Type: **Boots Core Plan**

This product has been designed to cover the costs of NHS treatment charged by NHS dentists only in England and Wales or to contribute towards the cost of NHS dental treatments in Scotland and Northern Ireland. Please read this benefit schedule in conjunction with the policy booklet to obtain the full terms and conditions. Your policy certificate will provide your policy number (to be used when making a claim) and other regulatory details.

General Information

Every time you make a claim in England or Wales, whether for one treatment or many, your dentist will advise you which Band Charge is applicable to you. If you require treatment across different bands we shall reimburse the patient charge for the highest band only. See Band description below.

Every time you make a claim in Scotland and Northern Ireland we shall pay an amount equal to the lowest of either; what you have paid or the banding appropriate for your most expensive treatment.

Regardless as to where the treatment is carried out, all claim forms must be fully completed and accompanied by the original receipts and submitted within 180 days of the last date of treatment. We will not be liable in respect of any claim notified late, unless there is a justifiable reason for the delay.

The benefits provided for the treatments listed below will only be provided where they are offered under the NHS regulations.

Reimbursement: The intention of the NHS band system is to only pay a single fee once a course of treatment is complete. The treatment rendered will determine which Band is charged. You will pay your NHS dentist the published patient charge for the applicable band. You will then claim this full cost from your Boots dental plan.
